





- Regular field trips that expose children to the outside world in a fun and an engaging manner.








The Early Years Foundation Stage

PROGRAM EYFS AND TRADITIONAL PRACTICES AT HAPPY HOURS

The EYFS is a framework for children set up in the UK that clearly prescribes the welfare and developmental goals a child must achieve upto the age of five in a nursery school. With a vast experience of over 30 years handing tiny tots, our teaching methodology has been perfected over the years to draw the attention of a child, keep his mind engaged and make learning creative and fun.

Motor Skills Development and Enhancement

Gross Motor Skill Development (walking, running, jumping, climbing, balance, strength)

Gross Motor development involves the larger, stronger muscle groups of the body. In early childhood, it is the development of these muscles that enable the baby to hold his/her head up, sit, crawl and eventually walk, run and skip.

Between the ages of 3 – 4 years, we ensure that our children can

- Run around obstacles
- Walk on a line.
- Balance on one foot for 5 10 seconds
- Hop on his/her preferred foot
- Ride a tricycle
- Walk up and down stairs with alternating feet, without support
- Jump from 12 inches with feet together

Between the ages of 4 – 5 years, we ensure that our children can:

- Walk a balance beam forwards & backwards
- Balance on 1 foot for 8 10 seconds
- Skip, alternating feet
- Begin to jump rope
- Throw a ball to hit a target
- Jump back
- Hop 5 times on 1 foot
- Climb the rungs of a playground slide ladder
- Fine Motor Skill Development (coloring, cutting, beading, lego, drawing)

"Fine motor" refers to the movements we make with the small muscles of the hands. Their fine motor skills develop as their whole body starts to move and become more stable. They also learn to do more things with their hands as their cognitive and social/emotional skills improve.

Below are some of the typical developmental milestones for fine motor skills.

Between the ages of 3-4 years, your child will:

- Build a tower of 9-10 small blocks
- Use playdough to make balls, snakes, cookies, etc.
- Build things with large linking blocks
- Draw a circle by themselves.
- Start to hold a crayon or pencil with a mature grasp (like an adult)
- Cut across a piece of paper
- Start to cut along a straight line
- Put on most items of clothing by herself, but may still need help with shirts and jackets
- Feed himself well with a spoon and fork



Programs Offered

To accommodate the requests of parents who entrust the care of their children in our hands, we conduct four shifts for the following classes

Junior 1 (LKG) - 3 to 4 years
Junior 2 (UKG) - 4 to 5 years
Preparatory - 5 years

Afternoon shift - 12:30 pm to 3:00 pm
Extended shift - 10:00 am to 3:00 pm
Full day shift - 9:00 am to 3:00 pm



Settling Period at Happy Hours

We want to make sure your child has the happiest start to school life at Happy Hours so we have put together a special plan to ensure this happens.

It is really important that the *teachers and parents work together* to guarantee this happens.

With all our years of experience and trials we now know that the best way for your child to separate from you, is with a confident farewell and to not stay too long. The longer the parent stays the harder it is for the child and for the teacher. If your child is very unhappy the teacher will always call you to request you to return back.

Each child is different and some children settle in very easily into school life, while others find it harder. Patience is key, as well as a consistent routine at home and at school, that really makes a big difference.

It is important that parents and staff communicate and work in partnership with each other to ensure we build a good foundation

for your child's time at Happy Hours.

***Literary Activities:**

*Artistic activities:


WATCH AND CEARN TIME

During this time, smaller children are taught to hear and observe bigger children around them recite rhymes, sing songs and listen to stories. This helps children gain confidence by observation and in turn improves their listening skills.

HAPPY HOURS EARLY EDUCATION RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Being associated with Charan's Group of Educational Institutions helps Happy Hours bring together a great team of scholars and research associates who specialize in innovation in early childhood education.

Our R&D team based in Toronto, Canada and Cambridge, UK explore new and innovative concept based learning methods and help us blend it into our curriculum on a regular basis. A specialized team continuously works on Theory of Multiple Intelligence to continuously update our teachers in the FDP (faculty development programmes) conducted every term.



Some of our latest research methodologies include work from PEDAL (Cambridge, UK)-Centre for Research on Play in Education ,HFRP (Harvard Family Research Programme) and CRRU (Childcare Resource and Research Unit, Canada).





HEACTH AND HYGIENE

At Happy Hours we believe that health and hygiene play an utmost important role in the well being of your child. When children are healthy, they are more enthusiastic, energetic and receptive to learning both inside and outside the classroom.

At Happy Hours, children are safe in a clean and a hygienic environment with our in house staff working continuously to keep the classrooms and the environment sparkling.

Our school doctor conducts a series of health check-ups annually for your child and a detailed health card is provided to every parent. Any parent wishing to meet the doctor is also given a one to one appointment to discuss any personal issue they might have with their child.





1. How do I know if my child is learning to speak and pronounce words correctly?

A: We take utmost care to ensure that the child understands the relationship between the spoken number, the symbol and the quantity. The child learns about shapes, sequencing and sorting through a combination of practical individual and group activities. Using the phonic method, sounds are gradually blended to form three (and more) letter words. Once a child is comfortable with 'sounding out' words, we progress to reading and writing.

2. How much writing will my child learn at Happy Hours?

A: Every child learns at his or her own pace. Our teachers take great care to ensure that letters and numbers are correctly formed. We encourage a firm pencil grip, creating smooth outlines and good clear shapes. Parents are always welcome to see their child's workbooks and the equipment they are learning to use.

3. My child is very shy at home. Will he come out of his shell at Happy Hours? How do you ensure that?

A: The children participate in a group singing and rhyme session every morning. They learn fun songs as well as traditional nursery rhymes but the underlying purpose of these sessions is to teach the children about working as a group, taking turns and listening to and following through instructions. During these lessons the children dance in their bare feet and learn about rhythm, posture, coordination and musical interpretation.

4. Will I be able to see my child's creative work at school?

A: There is a daily art/creative work session when the children have the chance to discover a wide range of creative activities. An art and craft exhibition for parents is arranged every year for the parents to come and visit the school. You will be invited to view a display of your child's work and discuss his or her progress.

5. How do I know if my child is progressing at the right pace for his age?

A: Detailed records for each child are kept at Happy Hours, and parents will receive a progress report at the end of every term. Parents are regularly updated by SMS on important announcements and emergency closures.
